

RICHARD C. POWELL, is Emeritus Vice President for Research and Graduate Studies and Professor of Optical Science at the University of Arizona. He received his B.S. degree from the United States Naval Academy, and his M.S. and Ph.D. degrees in physics from Arizona State University. He has held positions as a staff scientist at Air Force Cambridge Research Laboratories and Sandia National Laboratory and has held academic positions as a professor at Oklahoma State University and the University of Arizona. Powell's professional work is in the area of solid state spectroscopy and the development of solid-state lasers. He has authored three textbooks and over 260 scientific articles. Powell is an elected Fellow of both the American Physical Society and the Optical Society of America and has served as President of OSA. He has worked as a consultant for solar energy projects at Research Corporation for Science Advancement and Science Foundation Arizona.
